*From Stone to Steel:
Bringing English 15th-Century Armour Back To Life*

one of our main objectives is to promote the knowledge on those fields Hermann Historica is specialised in. Therefore we will support in future lectures with acknowledged specialists on their area of expertise that are related to Arms and Armour and other historical objects. Dr. Tobias Capwell, former Curator of Arms and Armour for the Glasgow Museums and recently appointed Curator of Arms and Armour at the Wallace Collection, London will give a lecture on English Armour in the 15th-Century.

Tobias Capwell's book, based on his PhD, „The English Style: Armour Design in England 1400-1500“, will be published soon. As well as numerous research and publications projects, Dr. Capwell has been involved in the re-display of the Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum. The new Kelvingrove, which will include extensive arms and armour displays, will re-open in 2006.

Dr. Capwell, as well as an academic, is also one of the worlds most experienced and successful jousting champions who has tested his abilities with a unique armour in the English style, circa 1440-60, built 2004 to 2006 by Robert Macpherson, one of the world's greatest living armourers. This armour has kept him alive in combat for two years in the tournament fields of England, Scotland, and the Netherlands.
